Drivers Briefing & COVID-19 Information

Information for drivers and pit crew during the Covid – 19 pandemic.

- All drivers must book in with Paypal or Bank transfer. Leaving your Name, Class you want to race, PT number, BRCA number, Junior or Senior in the notes section.
 - All race fees are to be paid at the time of booking into the event. This is done via PayPal or Bank Transfer.
 - Online entries can be done up until 7am on race day.
 - Drivers must be checked in by 8:30am on the morning of the event. Drivers not checked in by this time will be removed from the event.
 - Race control is off limits to anyone except for NDOR Officials.
- Face masks are optional. Please be respectful of other people's choices
- Drivers briefing is as below.

- The one way system of entering and leaving the rostrum and pit lane is to be followed to the letter. This is to maintain social distance and to minimise contact.
- Drivers must provide their own Hi-Vis vest and gloves for marshalling (These can't be disposable latex gloves - Working style gloves are recommended).
- Personal hand sanitiser is also recommended while you are at the venue.
- High Vis must be worn while marshalling. Gloves are recommended to be worn while you are marshalling and in the pit lane.
- If you become ill or exhibit any of the covid 19 symptoms at the track please inform a track official and then go home.
- All litter is your own responsibility and MUST be taken home with you.
- No smoking, e cigs or mobile phones used at your marshall point, in the pit lane or in the undercover pitting area.
- Drivers, please be respectful of all the marshals. No shouting abuse at them please, or you will receive a penalty.
- Marshalls, please pay attention to the cars in your marshaling area.
- If a car is unable to carry on racing, then marshalls must leave the car at their marshall point. It's the pit person's responsibility to retrieve the car.
- All drivers must place a number sticker on the front and left of their buggy / truggy. These are available on the rostrum.

Meeting Format

The meeting will be run as follows

- ❖ Qualifying will start at 9am, consisting of 4 x 7 minute rounds with 2 minute warm up with the best 2 to count.
 - ❖ Finals will be 15 minutes long for all classes (Weather Depending)
 - ❖ Bump ups will be determined on the day depending on numbers
 - ❖ The computer runs in automatic mode. So when the scoreboard says 2 minutes to the start of the race, the track is open and your 2 minute warm up has started. If you are marshalling this race you must be at your marshal point way before this time.
- NOTE: IF THE DRIVERS AND MARSHALS ARE IN POSITION, THE TRACK WILL OPEN SOONER FOR YOUR 2 MINUTE WARM UP

Remember: You Race and then you Marshall no exceptions unless you have a personal Marshall.

- ❖ There will be time between each race. However, if you need more time please ask one of the NDOR officials

Race Day Schedule

Gates open at 7.15am DO NOT come before this time please.

All drivers must arrive by 8.30 when booking in will close. If you have not arrived or contacted me by that time your name will be removed from the list.

Practice sessions commence at 9am immediately followed by racing.
